



Preparation of reagents 8.1

8.1.1 Preparation of 0.05 M EDTA

Weigh 18.6g of EDTA and transfer it to 1000ml volumetric flask. Add 500ml of RO water, and dissolve by sonication for 5minutes.Bring up volume to 1000ml with RO water and mix well.

8.1.2 Standardization of 0.05 M EDTA

Weigh 0.100g of zinc powder and transfer it in a 100ml volumetric flask. Add 4ml of 7M hydrochloric acid and dissolve by sonication. Add 0.1ml of bromine water, Boil to remove excess bromine, cool at room temperature and bring up volume to 100ml with water. Take 25ml of this solution with the help of a bulb pipette and transfer to a 500mi conical flask. Add 200ml of RO water. Add 50mg of xylenol orange triturate, the solution becomes yellow. Add hexamethylenetetramine until the color of solution turns violetpink from yellow. Add 2g of hexamethylenetetramine in excess. Titrate, with

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EDTA solution until violet-pink color turns yellow. Each ml of 0.05 M EDTA VS is equivalent to 3.269mg of Zn.

8.1.3 Preparation of 0.05 M Zinc sulphate solution

Weigh 8.79g of Zinc sulphate monohydrate and transfer it in a 1000ml volumetric flask.Add 500ml RO water and dissolve by sonication for 5 minutes. Bring up volume to 1000ml with RO water and mix well.

8.1.4 Standardization of 0.05 M zine sulphate solution

Transfer 10ml of 0.05 M EDTA solution in a 100ml conical flask with the help of 10ml bulb pipette. Add 10ml of acetic acid – ammonium acetate buffer pH 4.5, 50ml of ethanol and 2ml of dithizone. 

Accurately measure 33.5 ml of 35 % ammonia and transfer it to 100 ml volumetric flask. Bring up volume to 100 ml with RO water.

8.1.8 1N Sodium hydroxide

Accurately weigh 4.0 g sodium hydroxide to 100 ml volumetric flask. Add 50 ml RO water and sonicate for 15 minutes. Bring up volume to 100 ml with RO water.

Measure 26.10ml of concentrated hydrochloric acid and transfer it to 100 ml volumetric flask already containing 50 ml of RO water. Bring up volume to 100 ml with RO water and mix well by swirling.
